Waterproofing Coax Joints

If like me you enjoy operating outdoors during the summer months, how can you keep coaxial joints watertight without wasting yard's (metre's) of Self-Amalgamating tape and then having to peel it all off at the end of the day?

The simple answer is to always have a roll of clingfilm to hand, wrap the coaxial joint tightly in clingfilm and elevate the joint with a piece of wood or what ever you have to hand (Tupperware lunch box or similar) as water will seldom if ever migrate up hill. For added security bind both ends with a couple of turns of electrical tape or a reusable cable tie.
